#### EASTERN ECONOMIC FORUM NEWS

The seventh APEC International Conference on Education will be held during the EEF. The theme of the conference is: 'Education in the Digital Age: Challenges and Opportunities for APEC'. Roughly 100 delegates from Russia and countries of the Asia-Pacific region plan to take part in the event. (RIA News)

A project for the creation of the Arctic Advanced Special Economic Zone in Yakutia will be presented at the EEF. This territory is expected to include several investment projects related to subsoil use in difficult conditions, the manufacturing industry, energy, and other areas. (Eastrussia Information Agency)

The opening ceremony of the 'Far East Street' exhibition will be held on 9 September. The exhibition will present the economic potential, cultural traditions, and tourism opportunities of the Russian Far East as part of the EEF. (Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East)

An ecological trail that mirrors the outline of the Far East will be demonstrated at the EEF. The trail will be shown at the Far East Street exhibition and will introduce Forum guests to the nature of all the regions of the Far Eastern Federal District. (RIA News)

The Russian Ministry of Natural Resources will present Ecopark and 10 natural wonders of the Far East during the EEF. A huge 800-square metre exposition will be created on the embankment of the Far Eastern Federal University campus as part of the Far East Street exhibition. (Godnovosti.rf)

The main themes are: the role of the APR in the global economy, the development of investment potential and the improvement of living conditions in the Far East, and advanced technologies that are capable of driving the economy of the region and the country. **RUB 400** million will be allocated in 2018 to subsidize air transportation to the Russian Far East. This will support the sale of affordable tickets.
